Galatians 5:13-26

You, my brothers, were called to be free. But do not use your
freedom to indulge the sinful nature;

**The entire law is summed up in a single command:
"Love your neighbor as yourself."**

If you keep on biting and devouring each other, watch out
or you will be destroyed by each other. Live by the Spirit.

**So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires
