Dr. Melvin West

Dr. Melvin West, a native of St. Paul, Minnesota, was educated at Andrews University, Michigan, the University of Redlands, California, and Boston University, where he received the Doctor of Musical Arts degree. He is a Fellow of the American Guild of Organists.

Dr. West's college teaching began at Atlantic Union College in Massachusetts, which was followed by appointments at Walla Walla College in Washington and Union College in Lincoln, Nebraska. He has the distinction of being the first full-time minister of music in the Seventh-day Adventist Church, a position he held at Kettering, Ohio.

For many years he has held other positions as minister of music, choir director and organist — 60+ years in the Seventh-day Adventist Church and 55 years of that same period in the Presbyterian, Episcopal, Lutheran, and Congregational churches. Concurrently he was an organ recitalist.

Dr. West is sought after as a consultant with churches and schools regarding selection, installation, and tonal finishing of organs. He was the chairman of the Tunes Committee and associate editor of the *Seventh-day Adventist Hymnal* (1985), as well as editor of *Westminster Sings*, a 1988 supplemental hymnal for Westminster Presbyterian Church in Lincoln, Nebraska. His acquaintance with hymnody has resulted in many invitations to present hymn festivals across America as well as overseas.

In April 1996 Walla Walla College dedicated its Fine Arts Center as the *Melvin K. West Fine Arts Center*. Dr. West was primarily responsible for the design of this center, where he taught for 18 years, 15 of which were as Chairman of the Music Department.

Dr. West is married to Betty Ann, his wife of 55 years, and together they have enjoyed traveling, much of which has been overseas. But of particular interest and enjoyment is their three grandchildren.

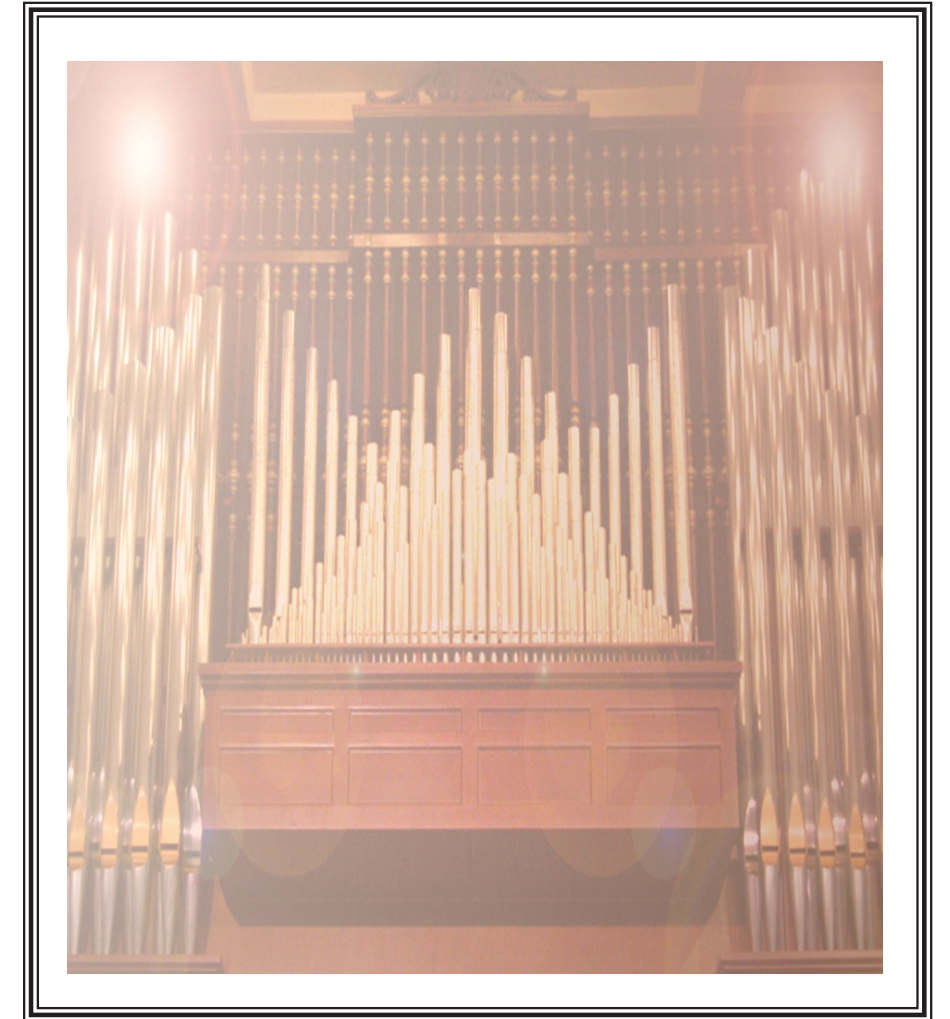
