Baptism. There will be a baptism in the upcoming month. If you are interested in being baptized, please speak with a pastor or church elder, or contact the church office.

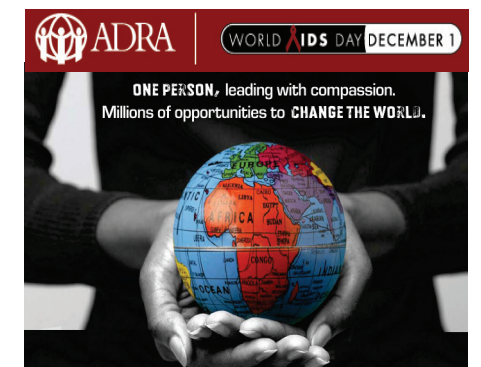
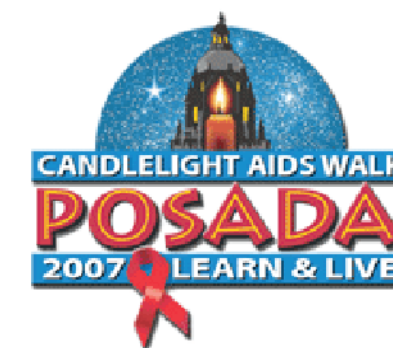
