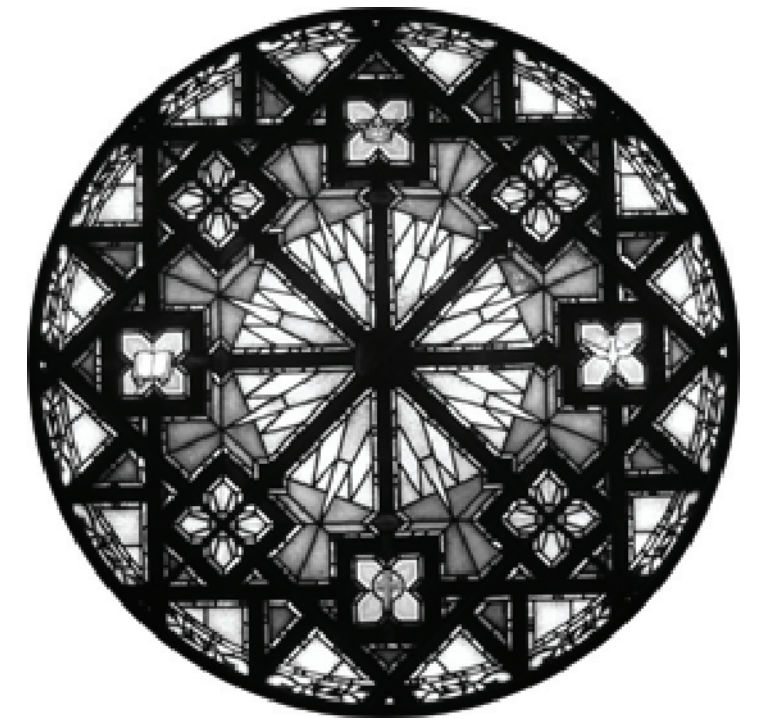

Deuteronomy 5:12-15; Hebrews 4:9-12

Observe the Sabbath day by keeping it holy,
