

Scripture Reading

Mark 5:24-34

So Jesus went with him [and] a large crowd followed and pressed around him.

And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years. She had suffered a great deal under the care of many doctors and had spent all she had, yet instead of getting better she grew worse.

When she heard about Jesus, she came up behind him in the crowd and touched his cloak, because she thought, "If I just touch his clothes, I will be healed."

Immediately her bleeding stopped and she felt in her body that she was freed from her suffering.

At once Jesus realized that power had gone out from him. He turned around in the crowd and asked,

"Who touched my clothes?"

"You see the people crowding against you," his disciples answered, "and yet you can ask, 'Who touched me?' "

But Jesus kept looking around to see who had done it. Then the woman, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell at his feet and, trembling with fear, told him the whole truth.

He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering."

Our Guest Speaker: Joe Cirigliano

Pastor Joe Cirigliano, born in the Bronx, NY, is North American Evangelism Coordinator for It Is Written Television. Whether training remote-tribe missionaries or big-city Bible workers, Joe loves to teach people to lead others to Jesus. He has conducted dozens of metro area evangelistic meetings and training seminars for more than 200 churches from coast-to-coast, regularly leads field schools of evangelism, and often speaks at Adventist universities.

Joe's family was led to the Adventist message in the 1970s when a local church secretary and her husband sent Signs of the Times Magazine to a former Adventist. The magazines were intercepted by Tony Cirigliano, Joe's uncle (a local postman at the time). It made a major impact on his life, and before moving away to become an Adventist minister, Tony shared the Advent hope with Joe's mother, and their family was forever changed.

For the past 14 years, Joe has served the Adventist Church in a variety of positions. He graduated with a Masters of Divinity from Andrews University Theological Seminary and will be continuing his education through Harvard's Extension School and Yale Divinity School.

While serving as the Atlanta area evangelist for the Georgia-Cumberland Conference, he tried a few different approaches to supplement prophetic evangelism like the "Dreams Alive Seminar" with keynote speaker Vince Lombardi, Jr. He was also the speaker for "Prophesy Again," an Atlanta-based television program, which aired to a million cable subscribers on the nation's largest interfaith channel. The program was nominated for "best continuous faith-based program in Atlanta."

Following his completion of the Billy Graham School of Evangelism in Times Square, Joe's revival preaching and evangelism preparation methods were part of a feature in Decision Magazine. He also received a special invitation to join the exclusive Billy Graham Evangelistic Association's emerging evangelists program.

He has been part of the It Is Written evangelism team since May 2006. He was the coordinator for the series in Portland, and is looking forward to the ministry's upcoming meetings in Los Angeles. We hope his ministry today will prove a blessing to all who attend.
