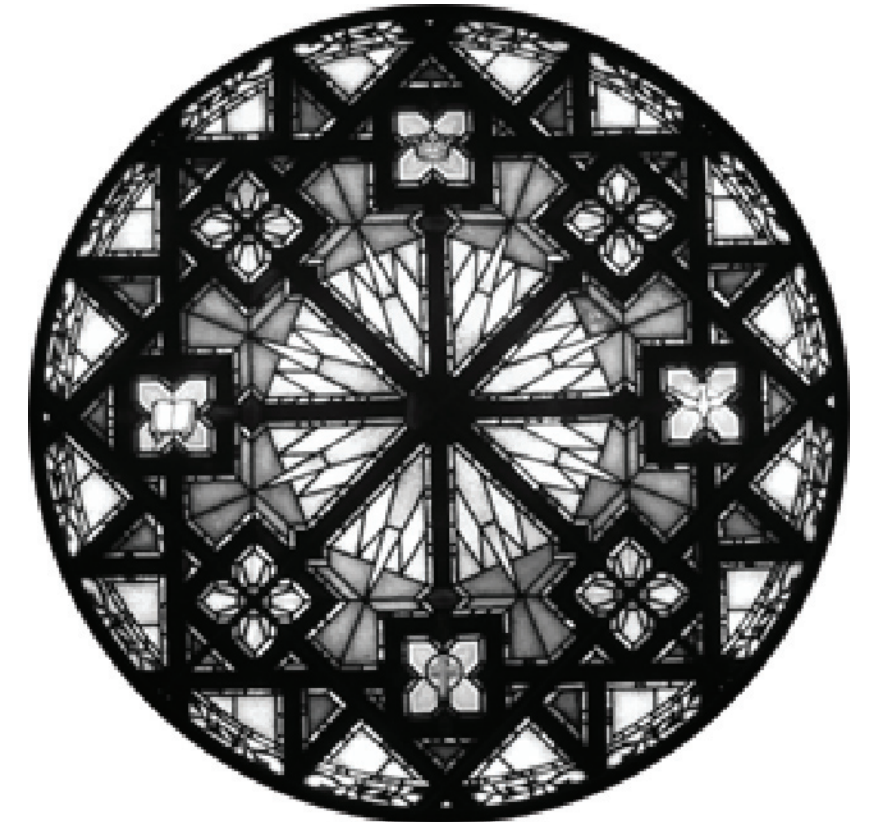

**1 John 4:9-10; John 3:17;
1 John 4:11, 16, 20, 21**

This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him.

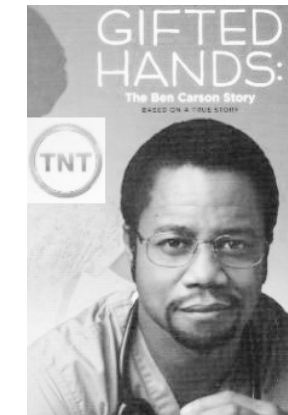
