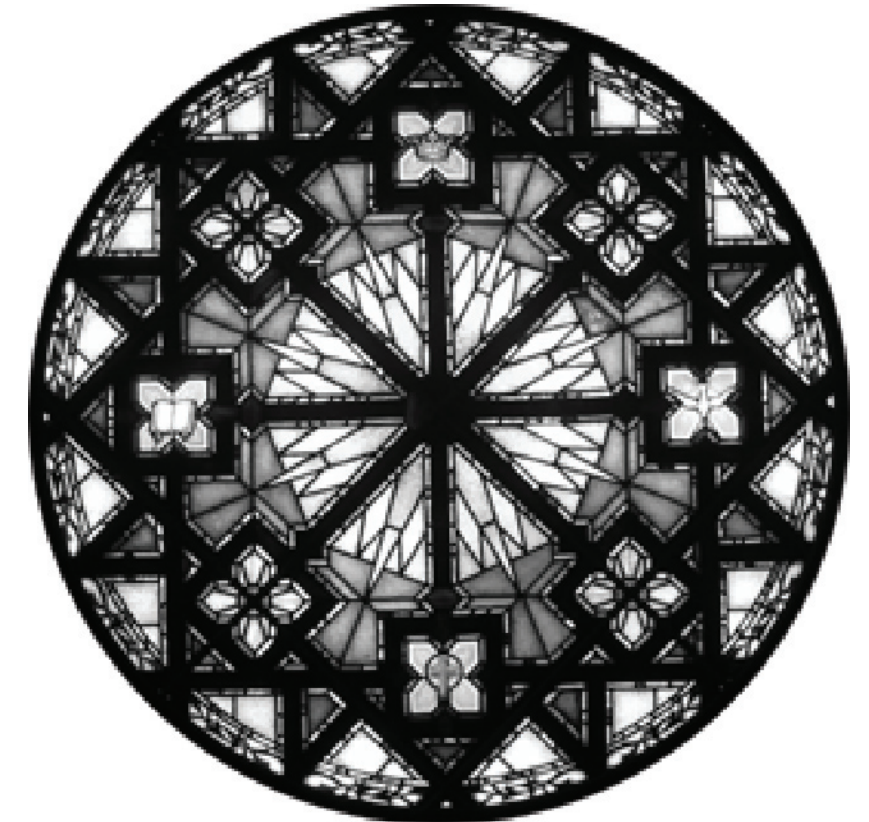

Scripture Reading

Mark 1:40-45; John 11:33-34, 38-44

A man with leprosy came to Jesus and begged on his knees, "If you are willing, you can make me clean."

Filled with compassion, Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. "I am willing," he said. "Be clean!" Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cured.

Jesus sent him away at once with a strong warning: "See that you don't tell this to anyone. But go, show yourself to the priest and offer the sacrifices that Moses commanded for your cleansing, as a testimony to them." Instead he went out and began to talk freely, spreading the news.

As a result, Jesus could no longer enter a town openly but stayed outside in lonely places. Yet the people still came to him from everywhere.



When Jesus saw Martha weeping he was deeply moved in spirit and troubled. "Where have you laid your brother Lazarus?" he asked. "Come and see, Lord," they replied. Jesus, once more deeply moved, came to the tomb. "Take away the stone," he said. "But, Lord," said Martha, "by this time there is a bad odor, for he has been there four days."

Jesus said, "Did I not tell you that if you believed, you would see the glory of God?" So they removed the stone. Jesus looked up saying, "Father, I thank you that you have heard me. 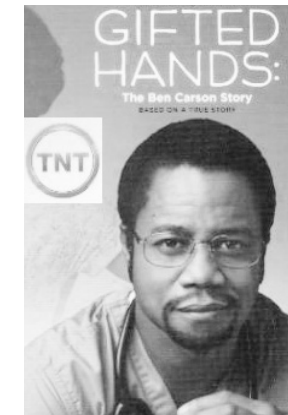
