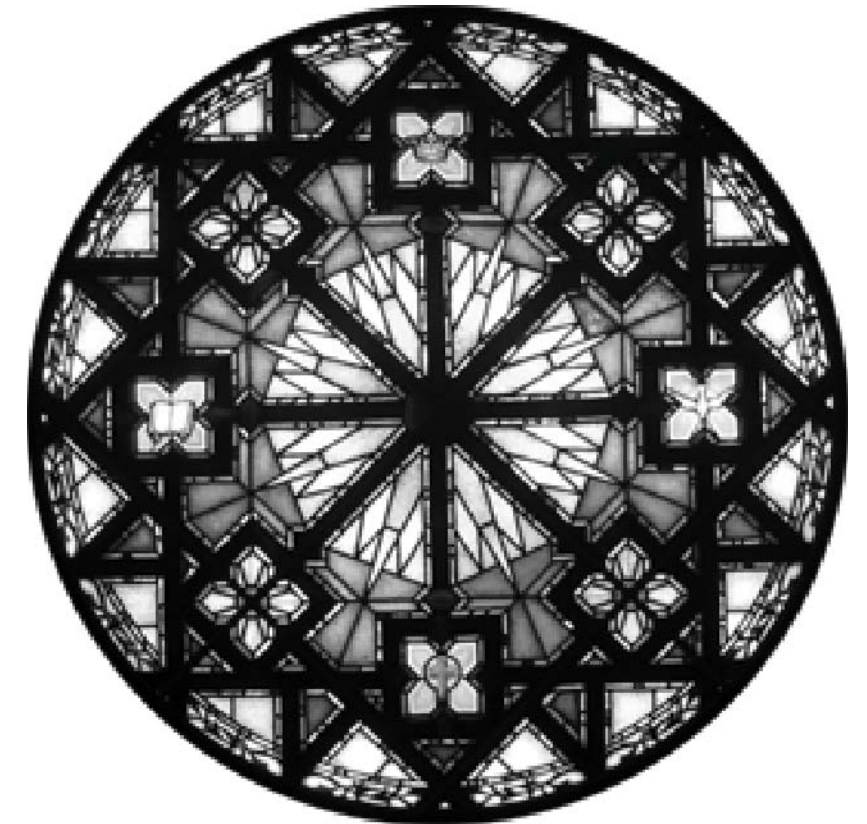

Isaiah 53:1-6;10-12
