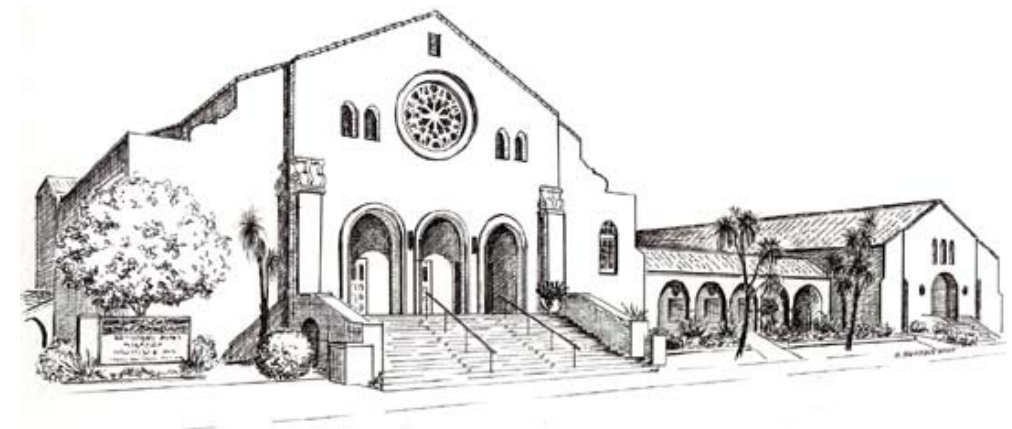

## Glendale City Health Education Program Says...

Are intrusive thoughts disrupting your sleep? The following tips may be helpful:

- ❖ Before retiring for the night, plan your next day and write it down.
- ❖ Approach bedtime with positive thoughts that you will be able to fall asleep: "I am (getting) sleepy. I will fall asleep."
- ❖ Keep a journal or pad of paper and pencil beside the bed to write down worries, concerns, ideas, and other thoughts you need to release.
- ❖ Beginning with the forehead, working down to the toes, tense each muscle group and count to 10, and then say to yourself, "Relax," and release the tension.
- ❖ In your mind's eye, go to your favorite place in the world and explore it, notice details of sight, sound, smell, touch, taste. Intrusive thoughts will begin to quiet down.
