HEALTHY HEART RECIPE

Enjoy this easy recipe served over brown rice or quinoa. Add a salad for a complete meal loaded with rich nutrients for a Healthy Heart!

Red Lentil Soup

1 cup dried lentils rinsed and drained
2½ cups butternut squash cubed in ¾" pieces
(or potatoes, or cauliflower)
½ cup each of chopped onion, carrot, and celery
2 garlic cloves, minced
1 teaspoon garam masala
4 cups low sodium vegetable broth

Add all ingredients to a 3½ to 4-quart slow cooker. Cover and cook on the low heat setting for 8 to 9 hours or on high heat setting for 4 to 4½ hours.
