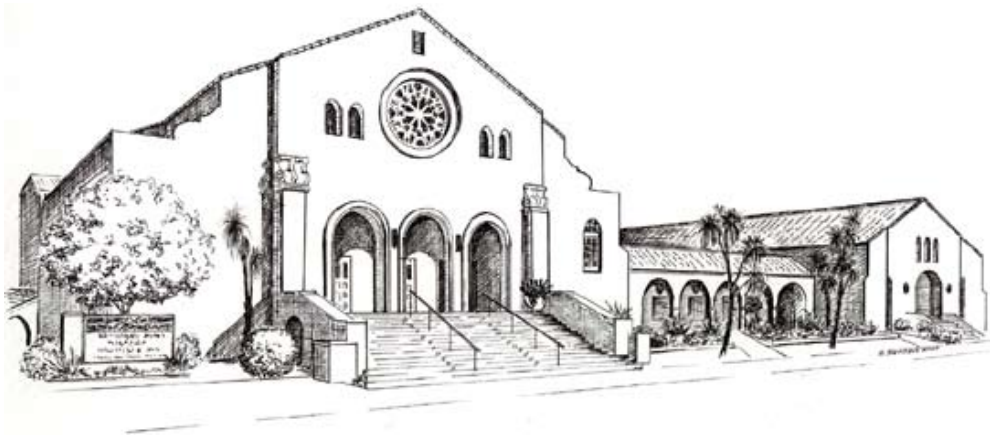

Scripture Reading

Matthew 28:1-7; 18-20

Glendale City Health Education Program Says...

We welcome **Dr. Jason Darlington**, ophthalmologist with Glendale
Eye, who will present an informative class on eye health, and treatments
for common eye diseases at 9:30 a.m. in the Fellowship Hall.

**Ever wonder what those numbers mean when you have your eyes
examined?** Visual acuity is written like a fraction: the top number
“20” represents the distance at which most people see the object
(letter); and bottom number represents the distance at which you see
the object. For example, a “normal” visual acuity of 20/20 means that
you see at 20 feet what most people should see at 20 feet. A visual
acuity of 20/100 means that you see at 20 feet what most people
see at 100 feet. California driver’s license requires 20/40 with both
eyes tested together AND 20/40 in one eye AND at least 20/70 in
the other eye.

What do common abbreviations on eyeglass prescriptions mean?
OD and **OS** are for the Latin terms *oculus dexter* (right eye), *oculus
sinister* (left eye). Some doctors now use **RE** for right eye and **LE** for
left eye. **OU**, *oculus uterque*, means “both eyes.” **SPH** or sphere, refers
to the amount of lens power needed to correct near- or farsightedness,
and is measured in diopters (**D**). A SPH number with a minus sign
(-) means you are nearsighted; a plus sign (+) or no sign means you
are farsighted. **CYL** (Cylinder) indicates the amount of lens power
in **D** for astigmatism, if present. If a prescription includes a CYL
power, it also has to include an x or axis value (from 1 to 180). **ADD**
is the amount of magnifying power to be added to the bottom part of
multifocal lenses (e.g., bifocals) and is written with a plus sign from
+0.75 to +3.00 **D** (also found on reading glasses for purchase at retail
stores). **Is it time for your next eye exam?**
