- CHAPEL — SABBATH SCHOOL QUARTERLY (TRADITIONAL): Current study theme: “Major Lessons from Minor Prophets” by Zdravko Stefanovic. Subtitled “Seek the Lord and Live”, these lessons examine how God worked through the last prophets of the Old Testament to reveal God's grace for fallen humanity.
