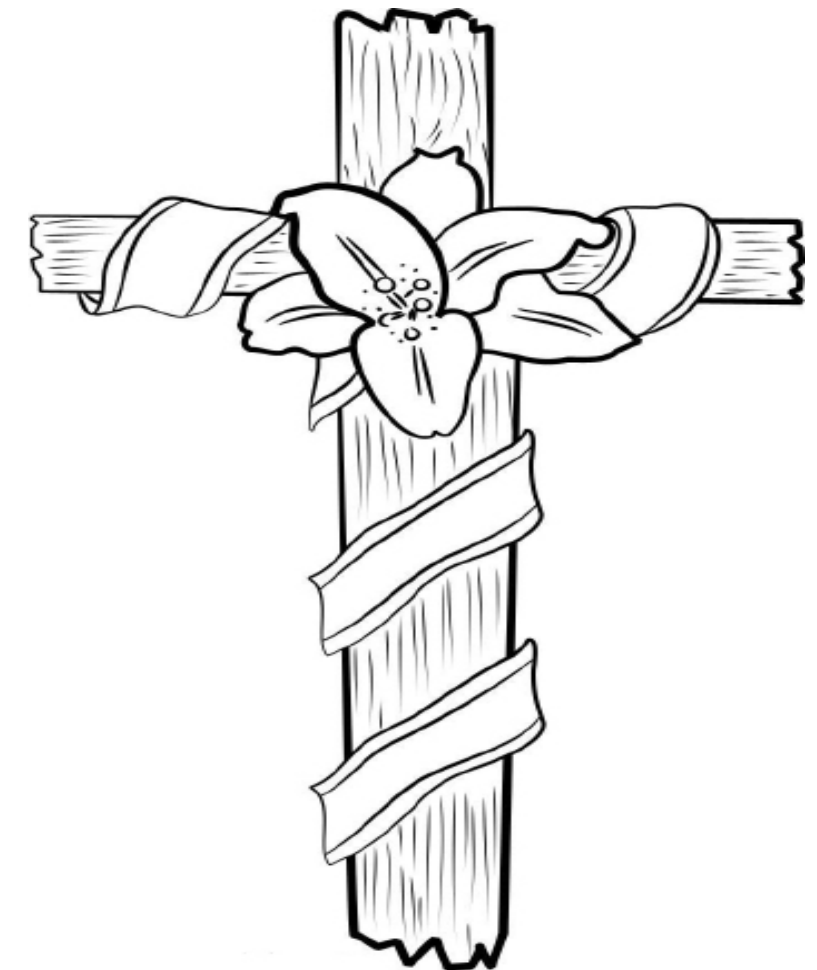

## Responsive Reading

### John 20:11-18
