Today's Speaker

Dr. Kendra Haloviak, Assistant Professor of New Testament Studies at La Sierra University, comes to us today as our guest speaker. She was born in Washington, DC, and grew up in the Maryland suburbs. After graduating from Takoma Academy, she attended the nearby Columbia Union College and received a B.A. in Theology and English in 1989.

After graduating, Kendra spent a year as an intern pastor at the Kettering Seventh-day Adventist Church in Ohio. In 1990 she began studies for her M.A. in Religion from Andrews University Theological Seminary. During that year Kendra became Associate Pastor for the University's Church.

In 1991 Kendra became part of the pastoral staff at the Sligo Seventh-day Adventist Church in Takoma Park, Maryland, joining the Religion Department at Columbia Union College in 1993.

Dr. Haloviak has for some time had a specialized interest in the book of Revelation, as indicated by her doctoral dissertation entitled: *“World at War, Nations in Song: Dialogic Imagination and Moral Vision in the Hymns of the Book of Revelation.”*

In July 2001 Kendra accepted an invitation to join the La Sierra University, Riverside staff as an assistant professor in the School of Religion.

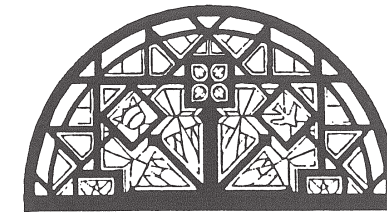
